

## CPCS A20B Hoist

The course is made up of 3 days:

### **DAY 1:**

- Is a day in the classroom. **The Theory.** There are 61 questions you must learn, you earn a set mark for every-one you answer correctly, the achievement rate is 116 out of a possible 145. (Home study in the evening is advised.)

### **DAY 2:**

This is broken up into two parts. **The Theory and Practical.** *Part 1,* You will go out onto the hoist where we go through the practical side of the test, showing you how to use the hoist correctly and safely, and teaching you how to carry out the manual lowering system procedure and running through what will be expected from you on the day of the test. *Part 2,* We will concentrate on the theory going over the questions again and again. (I advise this must be followed up by home study in the evening.)

### **DAY 3:**

This is the day of the test. **Which is carried out by a CPCS Tester.** You will be asked the questions verbally and you will answer them in the same manner, so you must have good communications skills and a good understanding of the English language, you have one hour to complete all the 61 questions. (You must pass the theory test to advance to the practical test.) The practical test will be carried out on the hoist, again you have one hour to complete the test, on completion you will be told.

Your HS&E touch screen must have to been taken in the last two years, you also need to bring photographic ID (i.e. Passport, driving licence.) with you on the day of the test, failure to do so will result in you being excluded from the test.

### PPE Must be worn during the practical test.

- Hard hat.
- Boots. (Protective toe.)
- Gloves.
- Protective glasses.
- Hi-vis.
